- Innovation/Commercialization/Technology
- Vascular/Lymphatic Biology and Diseases
- Craniofacial
- Nerve

The Program Committee is looking to create a broad and balanced program, but most of all we urge you to save your best and most thoughtful work for this prestigious meeting.

- In order for an abstract to be submitted to the PSRC Annual Meeting, it must have at least one (1) PSRC members on the author string.
- The submitting author will be **REQUIRED** to enter an email address for ALL co-authors.
- Please be sure to **INCLUDE** degrees for everyone on the author string
- If a paper has been presented at any other national, regional or international meeting it may be submitted to PSRC for consideration for the Annual Meeting program.
- If a paper has been previously published, it may **NOT** be submitted for consideration for a PSRC Annual Meeting program.
- **ACCEPTANCES.** If accepted on the program, the presenting or senior author **MUST** register within **TWO** weeks of the acceptance notification to secure their spot on the program. **NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.**
- Absolutely **NO** changes can be made to the title, author block or abstract **AFTER** the submission deadline. All submissions will be considered as final and will be published in the PRSC program and PRS GO as submitted.

PRESENTATION FORMATS

There are two presentation formats: Oral Presentation and Poster Presentation. When submitting an abstract, one of the following options must be selected:

- Oral Presentation
- Oral or Poster Presentation
- Poster Presentation Only

Please note the final presentation format will be determined by the PSRC Program Committee.

PREVIOUSLY PRESENTED WORK

If an abstract has been presented at another meeting, the work is eligible for submission to the PSRC Annual Meeting but acceptance will be at the Program Committee's discretion. Work that has been published is not accepted.

All authors will be prompted to disclose if their work has been previously presented and/or published. Please be sure to complete the detailed portion of this section within the submission-site, specifying the name of the conference/publication and where it was presented and/or published.

PLASTIC AND RECONSTRUCTIVE SURGERY JOURNAL

PSRC publishes all accepted abstracts for podium presentation in the Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery (PRS) Journal. The PSRC does not allow changes to the title, author block or abstract after the abstract submission deadline.

PSRC's Annual Meeting features awards for five different presenting author categories. Please review the award listing below to determine which award you are eligible for, if at all, and select the one (1) award you are eligible for during the submission process.

Award Categories:

John F. Crikelair - Research Award

Presented to the high school or college student presenting the best paper at the Annual Meeting of the Plastic Surgery Research Council

Clifford C. Snyder, MD - Past Chairman Award

Presented to the plastic surgery resident or fellow presenting the best paper at the Annual Meeting of the Plastic Surgery Research Council

Peter J. Gingrass, MD - Memorial Award

Presented to the medical student or non-plastic surgical resident presenting the best paper at the Annual Meeting of the Plastic Surgery Research Council

The Shenaq International Research Award

Presented to the best oral presentation at the Annual Meeting of the Plastic Surgery Research Council by a graduate of a foreign medical school (outside the US or Canada) who is currently performing plastic surgery research

The Clinical Research Award

Awarded for the best clinical paper presented at the Annual Meeting.
